Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.

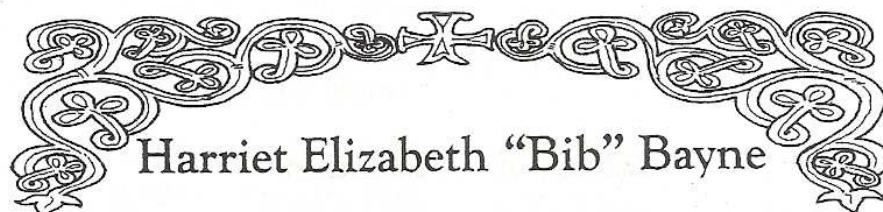
